**CERAMICS I**  
**10-11-12**  
**(1/2 Credit - 1 Semester)    026**

**\*Prerequisite: Art I**

Ceramics I is a basic pottery class which includes studio work in hand-building techniques. Students will create pieces using coil, slab, drape mold and combinations of these techniques. Glazing techniques and historical/cultural aspects of ceramics will be discussed. Development in the areas of art vocabulary, elements, principles of design, written expression, journal maintenance, daily participation, and deadline management are essential to the success of this course.

**A \$5.00 lab fee is required for this course.**

**CERAMICS II**  
**11-12**  
**(1 Credit - 1 Year)            027**  
**028**

**\*Prerequisite: Ceramics I**

This pottery class will include studio work in hand-building and wheel-throwing techniques. Students will continue refining skills developed in Ceramics I. Students incorporate their knowledge of design elements and principles into their creations, build studio management skills, and will demonstrate their knowledge, appreciation, and understanding of ceramics as an art form. **A \$5.00/10.00 lab fee is required for this course.**

**CERAMICS III**  
**11-12**  
**(1 Credit - 1 Year)            029**  
**030**

**\*Prerequisite: Ceramics II**

This is a course in wheel throwing. Students will produce quality original pieces and will continue to refine and develop techniques used in Ceramics I & II. Knowledge of glazing techniques will be broadened and an emphasis will be placed on the elements and principles of design. Studio time will include art history, information gathering, reflection, and career options. Students must be highly motivated and able to work independently. **A \$5.00/10.00 lab fee is required for this course.**
